What do I need to Participate?

- Students should select SIE as one of their 2023-24 Spring course requests.
- Students who participate will use their free 4th period at 12:37 p.m. (A or B) to leave school for an approved unpaid internship 2 to 3 times a week.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Teacher recommendation
- Successfully meet grade, attendance, and behavior requirements for semester 1 of senior year
- Must not have failed or be in danger of failing any senior-year
- Must complete the mandatory workplace safety Training
- Complete the Senior Graduation Survey
- Review and approval from parent/guardian, school counselor, principal, and SIE Coordinator

How do I earn Credit?

Sign up for an internship period with your school counselor. Students who successfully complete their internship can earn credit toward the *Mastery-Based Learning Assessment* graduation requirement.

1 When will SIE take place?

SIE takes place in the 2nd semester of a student's 12th-grade school year. This is a change from the way the old SIE was held

Can students go to their SIE during weekends and/or evening hours?

Yes, Only for **Self Design** students with approval from a parent/quardian.

What credit will be awarded when a student completes their SIE?

"Upon successful completion of 120 hours at an SIE placement, 1.0 credit will be awarded on the final transcript. All others will be awarded .5 credits.

What are the requirements for 10 participating?

- 1. Students must be in good standing, which means:
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Teacher recommendation
- Successfully meet the grade, attendance, and behavior requirements for semester 1 of senior year
- 2. Must not have failed or be in danger of failing any senior-year course
- 3. Must complete the mandatory workplace safety education
- 4. Complete the Senior Graduation Survey
- 5. Review and approval from parent/guardian, school counselor, principal, and SIE Coordinator

2 How do I sign up for SIE?

5 Is transportation provided?

No, but students will be matched to placements that are accessible. Students should find transportation to and from their placement. If there is an extenuating circumstance, contact Mrs. Lappas.

If the SIE takes place after school hours, how will credit be **8** awarded?

Students with placement after hours will have SIE placed in their schedule. This extra period will not count for attendance or grades. Upon successful completion, a credit will be awarded on their final transcript.

Are there any other 11 requirements?

Yes, participants must complete the mandatory workplace safety education before SIE begins. Approved SIE applicants will be given access to the virtual training module in December which contains 6 lessons and will take approximately 1h - 2h per lesson to complete at the student's convenience.

Will students leave school early **3** for their SIE?

Yes, participants will use their free 4th period at 12:37 p.m. (A or B) to leave school for their approved unpaid internship 2 to 3 times a week,

Can students participate if they have a full schedule already or

6 has other afterschool activities?

Yes, with approval from parent/guardian students can work with Ms. Lappas (SIE Coordinator) on finding a placement or self-design that works around their schedule.

Can SIE help meet the Mastery-Based Learning Assessment graduation requirement?

Yes. you must complete the 120 hours in your placement to get the 1 Mastery-based Learning Assessment credit. If you complete less than 120 hours you will only be awarded .5 credit. Therefore, you will need to choose a different way to get the Mastery-based Learning Assessment credit.
